On Saturday 27th February 2010 at 1130 hours up to 5,000 supporters of Whittington Hospital will form up in Holloway Road by Highbury Corner. At 1230 hours they will march to Whittington Hospital via Holloway Road, Highgate Hill, Magdala Avenue to Whittington Hospital.

Holloway Road Northbound will be closed to allow the marchers to form up and for the duration of the march. As the March progresses up Holloway Road approach Roads and East – West crossovers will be closed including Liverpool Road and Palmer Place at McKenzie Road, Camden road at York Way, Seven Sisters Road at Blackstock Road, Highgate Hill at Hornsey Lane.

Buses will be facilitated through the following police closure points: Seven Sisters Road at Blackstock Road, Seven Sisters Road at St Thomas Road, Seven Sisters Road at Isledon Road, Camden Road at Brecknock Road, Camden Road at Dalmeny Avenue, Camden Road at Parkhurst Road, Junction Road at Brecknock Road and Archway roundabout.

Buses must only divert/curtail when instructed to do so by either CentreComm, London Buses Officials or by the Metropolitan Police.

Buses will be diverted or curtailed as follows:-

ROUTE	Will be curtailed to terminate at Finsbury Park from the South from 1145 hours until Holloway Road has fully reopened.
4	Buses are to take minimum stand at this location

ROUTE 17	Will be diverted to curtail to terminate at Nags Head from the South from 1200 hours until Holloway Road has fully reopened. NORTHBOUND - towards Nags Head From Parkhurst Road at Williamson Street will then be diverted right Williamson street, right Camden Road to Stand. SOUTHBOUND - towards London Bridge From Camden Road Stand will then be diverted ahead Camden Road, left York way, left Market Road, right Caledonian Road and line of route.
ROUTE 29	Will be diverted to curtail to terminate at Camden Park Road from the South from 1200 hours until Holloway Road has fully reopened. NORTHBOUND - towards Camden Park Road From Camden Road at York Way will then be diverted right York Way, right Camden Park road to Stand. SOUTHBOUND - towards Trafalgar Square From Camden Park Road Stand will then be diverted ahead Camden Park Road, left York way and line of route.
ROUTE 41	Will be curtailed to terminate at Beaumont Rise from the North from 1300 hours until Archway has fully reopened.
ROUTE 43	NORTHBOUND - towards Friern Barnet From Highbury Corner at St Paul's Road will then be diverted right St Paul's Road, left Highbury Grove, ahead Highbury Park, ahead Blackstock Road, left Rock Street, right St Thomas Road, left Seven Sisters Road, left Isledon Road, ahead Tollington Road, right Hornsey Road, ahead Hornsey Rise, left Hazellville Road, left St Johns Way to Archway and line of route. SOUTHBOUND - towards London Bridge will not be diverted.
ROUTE 91	Will operate a split service from 1230 between Crouch End and Holloway Nags from the North. From Hornsey Road at Seven Sisters Road will then be diverted right Seven Sisters, right Isledon Road, ahead Tollington Road, right Hornsey Road to stand. From the South Between Trafalgar Square and Holloway Nags Head. NORTHBOUND - towards Nags Head From Parkhurst Road at Williamson Street will then be diverted right Williamson street, right Camden Road to Stand. SOUTHBOUND - towards Trafalgar Square From Camden Road Stand will then be diverted ahead Camden Road, left York way, left Market Road, right Caledonian Road and line of route.
ROUTE 134	From 1300 hours will operate a split service from the North between North Finchley and Archway. Buses should stand in Archway Road departing via Archway Roundabout into Archway Road. From the South between Tottenham Court Road and Archway. From Junction Road at Pemberton Gardens will then be diverted right Pemberton Gardens, right Pemberton Terrace, right Monnery Road, left Junction road to Stand.
ROUTE 143	Will be diverted to curtail to terminate at Highgate Village from the North from 1330 hours until Archway has fully reopened.
ROUTE 153	Will be diverted to curtail to terminate at Angel Islington from the North from 1200 hours until Archway has fully reopened.
ROUTE 210	EASTBOUND - towards Finsbury Park From Hampstead Lane at North Road will then be diverted left North Road, ahead North Hill, ahead Bakers Lane, right onto slip Road Archway Road, to Archway roundabout and line of route. SOUTHBOUND - towards Brent Cross From Highgate Hill at Archway will then be diverted right Archway, left Archway Road, left Bakers Lane, left North Hill, ahead North Road right Hampstead Lane and line of route.

ROUTE 253	Will be curtailed to terminate at Finsbury Park from the North from 1230 hours until Holloway Road has fully reopened.
ROUTE 254	Will be curtailed to terminate at Finsbury Park from the North from 1230 hours until Holloway Road has fully reopened.
ROUTE 259	Will be curtailed to terminate at Finsbury Park from the North from 1200 hours until Holloway Road has fully reopened.
ROUTE 263	Will be curtailed to terminate at Archway from the North from 1230 hours until Holloway Road has fully reopened. . Buses should stand in Archway Road departing via Archway Roundabout into Archway Road.
ROUTE 271	From 1130 hours will operate a split service from the North between Highgate Village and Archway . From the South between Liverpool Street and Highbury Corner until Holloway Road has fully reopened.
ROUTE 390	Will be diverted to curtail to terminate at Archway from the South from 1330 hours until Archway has fully reopened. From Junction Road at Pemberton Gardens will then be diverted right Pemberton Gardens, right Pemberton Terrace, right Monnery Road, left Junction road to Stand.
ROUTE 393	Will be curtailed to terminate at Highbury Corner from the South from 1130 hours until Holloway Road has fully reopened.
ROUTE C11	Will be diverted to curtail to terminate at Archway from the West from 1330 hours until Archway has fully reopened. From Raydon Street at Dartmouth Park Hill will then be diverted right Dartmouth Park Hill, left Bredgar Road, right Junction Road to Stand. Departing from Junction Road, left Pemberton Gardens, right Pemberton Terrace, right Monnery Road, right Junction Road, left Bickerton Road, left Dartmouth Park Hill and line of route.
ROUTE W5	Will be diverted to curtail to terminate at Archway from the North from 1330 hours until Archway has fully reopened. SOUTHBOUND - towards Archway From Stanhope Road at Hornsey Lane will then be diverted left Hornsey Lane right Sunnyside Road, right Sunnyside Road, right Hazellville Rd, left St Johns Way, circumnavigate Archway Roundabout into St Johns Way to Stand. Buses are to take minimum stand at this location NORTHBOUND - towards Harringay will depart Stand ahead St Johns Way, left Hazellville Road, left Hornsey Lane, right Stanhope Road to line of route.
